

Huachuca City Pool Fee Increases Support Data

Pool fees for the Huachuca City pool are lower than public pool fees in the surrounding area. Currently, Huachuca City charges \$1.00 per day for pool use regardless of age.

Many of the surrounding communities charge different pool admission fees for adults than they do for children. Fees range from \$2 to \$4 dollars per day for adults.

Costs associated with operating the pool have increased in recent years as wages have gone up. In an effort to defray increased operational expenses associated with the Huachuca City Pool, the Town of Huachuca City is proposing to increase fees as follows:

- Increase the daily pool fee from \$1.00 per day to \$3.00 per day for adults (age 18 and older).
- Fee for children (age 4-17) will remain unchanged at \$1.00 per day.
- Children 3 and under will remain free
- Summer pass fee will be \$50 for adult (age 18 and older)
- Summer pass fee for children (age 4 to 17) will be \$20.00.
- Pool rental fee will be set at \$75.00 per day (5 hours).
- Pool rental fee will be set at \$100.00 per day (5 hours) for non-residents.

Please note: Summer pool passes were not available for purchase in previous years. This is the first year that fees are being set for summer passes for the pool. Also pool rental fee is being set for the first time.

These proposed pool fee increases will be considered by Huachuca City Town Council on Thursday, June 28, 2018, at 7:00 pm, at Town Hall located at 500 N. Gonzales Blvd, Huachuca City, AZ.

If approved, these changes would go into effect immediately.
