Press Release-

The Huachuca City Town Council primary election is scheduled for Tuesday, August 28, 2018. The purpose of the election is to elect candidates for mayor and 4 council seats.

Candidates that receive a majority of the votes during the primary election will be declared elected without requiring them to run in the general election on November 6. If all of the open seats are not filled during the primary election, the candidates with the highest number of votes will proceed to the general election. The number of candidates that can proceed to the general election is two times the number of seats open. For this election, this would mean eight candidates for four seats.

The candidates currently running for Council in the primary election are Donna Johnson, Cynthia Butterworth and Joy Banks, all of whom are incumbents. Councilor Johann Wallace's seat is also up for election, but he is running for Mayor, along with Ken Taylor and George Nerhan.

A write-in candidate has requested a campaign packet and the deadline for write-in candidates to file is July 19. Any citizen of Huachuca City that runs as a write-in candidate must file and then their names will be posted at the polls.

The town urges anyone who is not currently registered to vote to do so prior to the July 30 deadline. Those interested can register online at <https://servicearizona.com> . The town also encourages those residents that are currently registered, to make sure they vote. Historically, only about 300-350 of the 920 registered voters in Huachuca City actually cast a vote.
