Prescribed Burning Planned at Keeline Park Area

Date: 06/27/2018 and 06/28/2018- The Whetstone Fire District, in cooperation with the Town of Huachuca City will be conducting prescribed burning operations on the West slope and western end of Keeline Park Area, approximately 4 acres west of the baseball field. Broadcast burning operations will occur as weather conditions permit, and could begin as early as this week.

Burning will only be conducted under specific guidelines established by the Division of Fire Prevention and Control, including having acceptable weather forecasts and fuels conditions that meet guidelines for safe and effective burning and adequate smoke dispersal.

The main objectives of this prescribed burn are to reduce hazardous fuel accumulation for the purpose of public safety and to reduce the potential of an accidental fire during fireworks display.

The Whetstone Fire District works closely with other agencies and local authorities in developing and implementing any burning project.

Burning may continue periodically in the area through the weekend as weather and fuel conditions permit.
